We will ask for the following materials from all Open Call applicants. Please note that we ask for all non-text documents (PDF's, work samples, videos) in link form. You may choose to host the file any way you like.

Keep in mind that the average arts reviewer takes 15 minutes or less to review your whole application in the first elimination round. There is more time for consideration and feedback after that. If you are linking to a video, please include markers.

Short Bio
(Less than 1200 characters)

Curriculum Vitae

Video Statement: Provide a link to a video statement about your practice. Don't spend more than 5 minutes making this video. (About 1 minute long)

In one sentence, what do you want to do at Eyebeam?

Tell us how your research relates to Power. What specific areas of the Open Call are you interested in?
(Less than 500 characters.)

Tell us about your practice, interests and field.
(Less than 500 characters)

What is the impact of you practice, potential or actual?
(Less than 1500 characters)

What do you need most to do your work?
(Less than 500 characters)

2 Work Samples with Description
